Education:

Alessandro achieved his High School Diploma (Liceo Classico I.S.I.S. Niccolini-Palli) with a **degree in classical studies** (maturità classica) in **2012**.

He then **graduated in Law** (Master of Arts in Law) on **21st July 2020** at the University of Pisa with the dissertation “Rilettura critica del Sistema italiano di garanzia della libertà religiosa in prospettiva *de iure condendo*” (Supervisors: Chiara Lapi and Pierluigi Consorti), obtaining the final grade of 110/110.

In the academic year 2020-21, Alessandro has attended a **Second Level Master** (Post Degree Specialization) **in Business Economy and Management at the University of Pisa** and passed the final examination on 10th December 2021. He also obtained the **Basic level diploma in Project Managing, issued by the Italian Institute of Project Management (ISIPM)**.

From September 2020 to November 2021, he also carried out an **internship at the Tribunale di Livorno, Sez. Lavoro (High Court of Livorno, Labour law sec.)**, as a legal expert, with the task to write drafts of judgements, decrees, ordinances, reports (sentenze, decreti, ordinanze, verbali) on behalf of the judge Federica Manfrè.

From October 2020 to April 2022, he carried out his **forensic apprenticeship at the Galli & Galdieri Law Firm** in Livorno, obtaining the final diploma, issued by the Livorno Bar Association, in June 2022.

From 1st December 2021 he is **Ph.D. Students (with full scholarship) in Human Rights and Global Policies: Legal, Philosophical and Economic Challenges at the Sant'Anna University - School for Advanced Studies in Pisa**. His research activities are about **the role of religious ethics and law in the challenge for environmental protection and sustainability**

Educational Activities:

From the academic year 2020/2021 to the present, he continuously **collaborates with the Law and Religion Chair of the Law Department of Pisa University** (Lecturers: Pierluigi Consorti, Chiara Lapi e Luigi Mariano Guzzo), holding classes within the courses of Law and Religion, Canon Law, Comparative Religious Laws, Intercultural Law and Non-Profit Organizations Law, also taking part to the final exams of those courses as a member of the relative examination committees.

In the same academic year, and also in the year 2022/23, he won a call issued by the University of Pisa to take a **semestral tutorship** for the implementation of innovative teaching methods in the fields mentioned above.

Research Activities:

In the Academic Year 2021/22, from October 2021 to March 2022, He obtained a Six months research grant, issued by the University of Pisa, Department of Law, in the field of Non-Profit Organization Law. The activity consisted in serving as a researcher and consultant delegated by the University to support the association Croce Verde in Pietrasanta (Lu) in a comprehensive reform process aimed at aligning its internal regulations with the new Third Sector Code. My activities also included providing business consulting to reorganize the various productive sectors of the organization self (funeral services, emergency-urgent

transportation, nursing homes, civil protection) in order to ensure their long-term economic and financial sustainability.

In the same year, he also took part, with Professors Pierluigi Consorti, Emanuele Rossi e Luca Gori, in the editing of a collection of national and international regulations related to non-profit organizations, published by the Pisa University Press in 2023.

Management Assignments and other relevant activities:

From January 2018 to December 2020, Alessandro was **member of the administration council (Concistoro) of the Congregazione Olandese-Alemanna** in Livorno, with a **legal affairs and public relationships mandate**, responsible for the recovery and enhancement of the ancient Monumental Cemetery placed in Livorno, Via M. Mastacchi, and the

neo-gothic “Tempio degli Olandesi” in collaboration with the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands. In this capacity, he was co-founder and referent of the project "**The Temple - Contemporary Art Pavillion**", with the aim of transforming the Temple into an exhibition hall for contemporary artworks of international level without affecting its specific functions as a place of worship. As a matter of fact, the first exhibition, scheduled for September 2022, is about original and unpublished works by the international artist Michelangelo Pistoletto (Artistic Director: Prof. Ludovico Pratesi, Accademia di Belle Arti di Urbino). The Congregazione Olandese-Alemanna, founded in 1622, is one of the oldest non-Catholic bodies of worship in Italy.

From February 2018 to March 2019, he **collaborated with the Christian Evangelical Union of the Italian Baptist Churches (UCEBI)** for the out-of-court legal defence of the association in matters of religious buildings and religious freedom, specifically for a long-term dispute with the Municipality of Livorno. The assignment ceased due to the full achievement of all the related goals.

From April 2019 to December 2021, he has also been **member of the “Special Committee for the Relationships with the Italian State and the International Institutions” of the Apostolic Church in Italy**, with the mandate to personally represent the Church in all public and private bodies, including political ones, competent by subject (Presidency of the Council of Ministers, Presidency of the Republic, Parliament, etc.) and negotiate – on behalf of the Church – many agreements with local and national authorities.

From January 2020 to December 2021, he **collaborated with the CISL-FP Tuscan Trade Union** for the protection of workers' rights, carrying out advanced legal consultancy and also representing the trade union in multilevel negotiations.

Additional skills:

Excellent knowledge of classical Greek and Latin. Good translation skills for inscriptions in the Etruscan language and Egyptian hieroglyphs with the help of a dictionary. Basic knowledge of the Turkish language.
