Job Position

The Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies announces a public selection call based on qualifications and competitive exams for two technical staff members. The contracts are permanent, with placement in D grade, economic position D1. These roles will provide technical support to the Department of Excellence L'EMbeDS.

Main duties and activities

The successful candidates will fulfill specialized technical tasks, managing, supporting, and planning infrastructure for research and teaching. Relatedly, he/she will take care of the planning, installation, configuration, and operational management of the IT infrastructure of the Department of Excellence L'EMbeDS, mainly based on Hyper-V and VMware technologies, as well as supporting the activities and maintenance of the multifunction laboratory of the same Department. Finally, the successful candidate will have to support the development of tools and code used within the L'EMbeDS research programs, including the development and application of data science, statistical learning, and machine learning techniques.

Admission Requirements

Applicants must hold:

- Bachelor's degree in Chemistry or Computer Science or Information Engineering or Industrial Engineering or Mathematics or Physics or Statistics
Or Master's degree in Actuarial and Financial Statistics or Automation Engineering or Chemistry or Computer Engineering or Computer Science or Cybersecurity or Data Science or Engineering Management or Mathematical-physical Modelling for Engineering or Mathematics or Physics or Statistics.
- Good knowledge of both English and Italian.
- In order to work in Italy as public employees, non-EU citizens need a long-term residence permit or the status of refugee or otherwise in need of international protection, i.e. the subsidiary protection status pursuant to Legislative Decree n° 251/2007 or the status of family member of the holder of subsidiary protection status present in the Italian national territory pursuant to art. 22, paragraphs 2 and 3 of Legislative Decree n° 251/2007 (specifying in the application the relevant residence permit).
