

Summary of the Rector's Decree nr 711 of December, 14, 2016

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR no. TWO NON TENURE -TRACK FIXED TERM ASSISTANT PROFESSOR POSITIONS

Academic Recruitment Field 09/G2 "Bioengineering" - Academic Discipline ING-IND/34 "Industrial Bioengineering"

The Sant'Anna Scuola Universitaria Superiore Pisa (Sant'Anna School) announces a call for the recruitment of <u>two non tenure-track fixed term assistant professors</u> (ricercatori a tempo determinato) with full time temporary contract pursuant to Italian Law no. 240/2010, art. 24 paragraph 3 letter A in the Academic Recruitment Field (SC 09/B2) at the Institute of BioRobotics for the following positions .

<u>Position A (Profilo A)</u> Research activities will be in the field of Neural Engineering, Neuroprosthetics, Neuromorphic Engineering, and Neuro-robotics. The Assistant Professor will develop innovative devices and algorithms for the modeling of the mechanisms underlying nervous system functions and for their validation by means of robotic platforms, for the restoration and augmentation of upper and lower limb sensorimotor functions, and for the neuromodulation of the autonomic nervous system. Didactic activity is also required.

<u>Position B (Profilo B)</u> The successful candidate will pursue research in the framework of wearable robotics for the restoration/augmentation/rehabilitation of the sensory and motor functions of the upper and lower limbs. In particular he/she will design, integrate and develop biomechatronic devices, sensing systems, methods for the control or the sensory feedback of actuated exoskeletons or prostheses, in addition to assessment procedures aimed to evaluating them functionally. Didactic activity is also required.

Duration of the contract: three years.

Salary: 34.898,06 € gross per year.

Admission Requirements:

Candidates must satisfy the following requirements:

- <u>Position A (Profilo A)</u>: to hold a PhD or equivalent in the following areas: Bioengineering, BioRobotics, Neuroscience, Neurobiology;
- Position B (Profilo B) to hold a PhD or equivalent;
- For each positions A and B: to have excellent knowledge of both written and spoken English.

Others Requirements

Candidates must supply:

- their PhD thesis
- no more than 12 publications

Who Can't Apply

- Those who, at the date of the deadline for application, are or have been professors or assistant professors who achieved tenure.
- Those who, at the date of the application deadline, are related, within the fourth degree, by blood or by marriage to professors of Sant'Anna School, or to the Rector (Rettore) or to the Managing Director (Directore Generale), or to a member of the Board of Directors (Consiglio di Amministrazione) of Sant'Anna School.
