Test examinations	Candidates are asked to take into account the research fields and interests of the Members of the Ph.D. in Law board, as they feature in the website of the Ph.D. in Law http://www.phdinlaw.santannapisa.it/ and in the general website of the School https://www.santannapisa.it/en/education/coordinator-and-board Eligibility for the competition is established beforehand by the Ph.D. board acting as
	a pre-selection committee and assessing the coherence of the research projects submitted with the lines of research followed by the course teaching staff, and with the scientific-disciplinary sectors covered by them.
	Selection from eligible candidates, following the said assessment, is carried out by an Examining Board. Selection from eligible candidates will be performed through an assessment of the qualifications presented and an interview. Assessment will be based on a scale of 1 to 100 points.
	Assessment of Qualifications – maximum score possible: 70 The Examining Board will assess the scientific qualifications submitted, the candidate's CV and his/her research plan (with regard to quality and relevance with respect to the PhD research areas). Those candidates obtaining a score of at least 49/70 in the assessment phase will be accepted for interview.
	Candidates are not required to be present during the assessment of qualifications.
	Interview – maximum score possible: 30 The interview will focus on the qualifications submitted, the proposed research project and on the level of knowledge of English. Those candidates obtaining a score below 21/30 will be excluded from the merit ranking list. At the discretion of the Board, the interview may be carried out as a video conference. In this case, the identity document used in the online application form must be shown before the start of the test in order to enable identification of the candidate. It is in any case the candidate's responsibility to make sure that required hardware (PC, webcam) and software are available and that there is a reliable internet connection. A minimum score of 70/100 is necessary to be accepted for the PhD.



	The school will notify scholarship holders of their admission to the School using the email address given in the application; the said scholarship holders will be required to confirm their acceptance by responding within 7 days to phddirpolis@santannapisa.it . If they fail to reply by that date, the position will be awarded to the first suitable candidate on the ranking list.
