Biography: Catriona M. Steele is a clinician scientist working in the area of swallowing and swallowing disorders. She has a background as a medical speechlanguage pathologist, and is Director of the Swallowing Research Rehabilitation Laboratory (www.steeleswallowinglab.ca) at the KITE Research Institute, the research arm of the Toronto Rehabilitation Institute - University Health Network. Dr. Steele is a the Department of Speech-Language Professor Pathology at the University of Toronto and holds a Canada Research Chair in Swallowing and Food Oral Processing.



Professor Steele holds research funding from the National Institutes of Health (USA) as well as several active industry partnerships.
