



Summary of the Rector's Decree no. 127 of March,6, 2020

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ONE FIXED TERM ASSISTANT PROFESSOR POSITION

The Sant'Anna Scuola Universitaria Superiore Pisa (Sant'Anna School) announces a call for the recruitment of one assistant professor (ricercatore a tempo determinato) with full time temporary contract pursuant to Italian Law no. 240/2010, art. 24 paragraph 3 letter A at the Institute of Economics for the activities of the Institute of Communication, Information and Perception Technologies in the **Academic Discipline “Electronics”** (09/E3 Elettronica) – **Academic Discipline “Electronic Engineering”** (ING-INF/01 Elettronica).

The research activity will focus mainly on the study of the use of FPGAs for the implementation of processing functions at the “edge” of telecommunications networks that require high performance and low energy consumption. Particular attention will be dedicated to the implementation of functions related to protocol architecture of the fifth generation of mobile networks (5G) and to the Operator Defined Generation RAN Architecture and Interfaces (O-RAN).

The assistant professor will also teach at the undergraduate (allievi ordinari), Masters (allievi Laurea Magistrale) and doctoral (allievi perfezionandi/PhD, alta formazione) levels – both in the School and in its federated institutions: Istituto Universitario di Studi Superiori di Pavia and Scuola Normale Superiore di Pisa.

Candidates can submit no more than 16 publications

Duration of the contracts: three years.

Salary: 35.733 € gross per year.

Admission Requirements:

Candidates must satisfy the following requirements:

- to hold a PhD or equivalent. If the PhD degree or equivalent qualification has been awarded abroad, candidates must provide the documents which certify that these qualifications are considered equivalent according to the Italian law in force (equipollence/equivalence-recognition of degrees). If candidates do not comply with the requirement while submitting the application, they will be admitted to the selection under condition and, if winners, they have to submit all necessary documents certifying that their qualifications are considered equivalent according to the Italian law in force by the date of the signature of the contract¹.

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- to have an excellent knowledge of both written and spoken English.

Who Can't Apply

- Those who, at the date of the deadline for application, are or have been professors or assistant professors who achieved tenure.
- Those who, at the date of the application deadline, are related, within the fourth degree, by blood or by marriage to professors of Sant'Anna School, or to the Rector (Rettore) or to the Managing Director (Direttore Generale), or to a member of the Board of Directors (Consiglio di Amministrazione) of Sant'Anna School.

Selection process and calendar:

The evaluation committee will be appointed by the Director of the Scuola Sant'Anna. A restricted number of applicants, to be admitted to a final interview, will be selected by the committee, **on the basis of cv's, publications and qualifications.**
