The details of the seminar and lectures will be decided in cooperation with the Course/Program Coordinator.

Candidates who apply for the selection must possess, under penalty of exclusion, at the deadline date for applications submission, a University Degree (Italian university "old system") or a Master's Degree and specific teaching experience on the subject matters of this announcement.

- academic qualifications (bachelor's and master's degree, doctorate, postgraduate diplomas, research grants)
- relevant work experience
- publications relevant to the topics covered in the courses for which the candidate applied for
- teaching experience on the topics for which the candidate is applying

The Advanced Education Office will stipulate the appropriate contract for the teaching assignment (coordinated and continuous collaborations contract, temporary self-employed contract). In the event that the assignee is employed by a public institution, prior to the assignment, she/he is requested to send to the Advanced Education Office appropriate authorization issued by the public institution, in accordance.
