#### **Job Position**

Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies announces a public selection based on qualification and competitive exams for one technology expert, following art. 24-bis L. 240/2010. The contract will run for 18 months, with placement in D category, economic position D3, at the Institute of Life Sciences of Sant'Anna School for Advanced Studies. This role will provide support to the following projects: PROGETTO STRATEGICO and PROGETTO PIANTA.

### Main duties and activities

This role will provide managerial and technical support to the research activities concerning the metabolomic analysis of both organic and inorganic complex matrices, derived from experiments with plants and animals or from their further industrial processing. Skills in the planning and managing of tests in laboratory, in open field and in a controlled environment are required.

### Admission Requirements

Applicants must hold:

- Master Degree in Agricultural Biotechnologies or Agricultural Science and Technology or Biology or Chemistry or Food Sciences or Industrial Biotechnologies or Industrial Chemistry or Medical, Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Biotechnologies;
