Position and grant

Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna announces a call to assign one Research Fellowship to perform research activities related to the scientific field SPS/01 -Political Philosophy at the Institute of Law, Politics and Development. The gross amount of the fellowship is 19.367,00 € per year. The present fellowship cannot be cumulated with other fellowships and grants except those aimed at financing a period of stay abroad necessary within the research activity. The duration of the research fellowship is 12 months, renewable in case of positive evaluation of the research activities performed.

Research Activity

- Research title DIRPOLIS strategic project: "Integrity, Security and Governance of New Technologies and Risks"
 - **Research description** "The research project Political Imaginary, Posthuman Philosophy and Emerging Technologies focuses on the critical relationship necessary to frame the new technologies and correlate risks with respect to the interaction with the human and with the latent or already current dimensions of the posthuman condition, as defined by an already extensive literature, to be taken as a state of the art. "Governance" is understood as a theoretical, symbolic and political analysis of certain technological developments, to be dealt with from a hermeneutical as well as regulatory perspective; this analysis will be conducted from the point of view of inclusive security, reliability and legitimacy of the relationship between human and non-human. The axiological core will be implemented in the machine through bottom-up learning models. 1) These analyses will be carried out starting from the most recent and problematic prospects and achievements in the field of Human Enhancement and hybridization between human and machine. 2) At the methodological level, there will also be a preliminary phase of elaboration, through mental experiments, of the conditions of a robotic "faculty of judgement", based on the logical structure of Isaac Asimov's "Zeroth Law". 3) At the impact level on society and politics, a number of diagnostic tools (including the analysis of common language in various ways, the deconstruction of stereotypes, the semistructured individual and group interview and/or the participatory table) will be prepared in order to decode and identify at an early stage the models and codes of behaviour and emotional reaction incompatible with the new or unprecedented cases of emerging subjectivities, whether non-human (artificial) or posthuman (hybrid and interspeciesist). The aim is to avoid and prevent new forms of exclusion and racism, incompatible with an inclusive and hospitable society, in which protection, security and rights are not irreconcilable, on the contrary they are synergistic. In particular, the line of research that is the subject of this post-doc position revolves around some roboethical dilemmas, which are also political, if we read the political dimension in a posthuman rather than anthropocentric vein. These dilemmas are made increasingly relevant and mutually interconnected by recent developments in robotics and artificial intelligence, filtered through the global imagery. In the global imagery, fictional or already existing relationships emerge among us "human beings" and the "non-natural born of woman", which are the "not born of woman" or the artificial and/or hybrid beings and artificial immaterial entities. It is therefore a question of translating the most relevant of these

visual, symbolic, pragmatic constellations into ethical-political reflection about the possible configurations of the future (present) societies of the future, which are not necessarily dystopic, but rather both desirable and feasible. In particular, the post-doc will be required: 1) to collect the most recent and problematic interventions and projections in the field of Human Enhancement and hybridization between human and machine; 2) to select the literature and the cases to identify, at an experimental level, the hypothetical conditions of a robotic "faculty of Judgement", based on the logical structure of Isaac Asimov's Zeroth Law; 3) to contribute to structuring and implementing, adapting them to the specific topic, some of the already existing diagnostic tools (among which, the analysis of the common language, the deconstruction of stereotypes, the semi-structured individual and group interview and/or the participative table)."

Admission Requirements

Applicants must hold a MSc Degree in Philosophy (LM-78), Political science (LM-62), International relations (LM-52), Economics (LM-56), Public administration (LM-63), Development co-operation (LM-81), European studies (LM-90), Law (LMG/01).

Selection method and ranking list

The selection is based on the assessment of qualifications and an interview for a total of 100 points, of which 65 points are for the assessment of qualifications and 35 points are for the interview.

Assessment of qualifications:

Scientific publications: 15 points

The candidate will be admitted to the interview if he/she obtains at least 40 points in the evaluation of the titles and will pass the interview obtaining at least 20 points.

A ranking list of eligible candidates will be drawn up by the examination committee at the end of the selection.
