

**ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE PRIZE NAMED AFTER PROF. GIAN TOMMASO
SCARASCIA MUGNOZZA
YEAR 2012**

Accademia Nazionale delle Scienze detta dei XL, i.e. Italian National Academy of Sciences, and Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna di Pisa announce a competition for a Prize corresponding to € 5,000 (tax excluded) to a young researcher who discussed the best PhD thesis addressing topics relevant to Plant and/or Agricultural Genetics. The PhD degree should have been issued by an Italian Academic Institution in the twelve months before the dead-line of this announcement.

Applicants must send to the administration of the Institute of Life Sciences of Scuola superiore Sant'Anna di Pisa the application and the requested documentation by 31st of October 2012, according to either one of the following procedures:

- a) by e-mail, addressing the application to protocollo@sssup.legalmailpa.it specifying as object "Application to Prize Gian Tommaso Scarascia Mugnozza";
- b) by regular mail to the address: Segreteria Amministrativa - Institute of Life Sciences, Via Santa Cecilia 3, 56127 Pisa (PI), with documentation possibly in electronic format (PDF on a CD).

For the application sent by regular mail it will be considered the date stamped by the Postal Office. However applications received seven days after the dead-line will not be considered.

Together with the application each applicant must include the following documentation:

- a) copy of the PhD thesis signed by the supervisor;
- b) copy of the PhD Degree;
- c) copy of scientific publication (if any) published in peer review journals derived from the research activity carried out during the doctorate;
- d) copy of a personal identification document

The prize Gian Tommaso Scarascia Mugnozza will be assigned by a Committee jointly appointed by Accademia Nazionale delle Scienze and Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna
