DATA CONTROLLER

Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies, represented by the Rector, as Data Controller, under the article 13 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation n. 679/2016 and under the Italian Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 ("Privacy Code regarding the protection of personal data"), as modified by the Italian Legislative Decree 101/2018, with regard to the processing of personal data, an on his behalf, the internal authorized processor Professor Barbara Henry, Project Coordinator (e-mail: barbara.henry@santannapisa.it) and other instructed, therefore authorized, employees of the Scuola will process your data.

PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

The Data Controller processes personal data collected during the Jean Monnet Project EUPATH from Governance to Government project (name, contacts, images) will be processed by the School in order to managing the administrative applications related to the. The legal basis of the data processing is recalled under article 6 *sub* b), c), e) of the EU Reg. 679/2016.

It is assured that your data will be processed in compliance with the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency, and Public Administration efficiency. In particular, your data will be collected and stored in the School ICT systems (e.g. in house database and U-GOV platform) as well as paper records will be stored in the Schools offices.

Your data will be processed, stored and communicated in compliance with the European and national legislation on the subject (Reg. EU n. 679/2016 and Legislative Decree n. 196/2003) for the entire term of our relationship with you and, as far as accounting data for a maximum of 10 years thereafter. At the end of these periods, the data will be deleted or rendered anonymous.

Your personal data will not be communicated to third parties, except for the EU Commission, and other private/public entities in order to fulfil legal obligations connected to the project.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

As data subjects, you shall have the right to obtain at any time confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning them exist, to be informed of the content and source of such data, to check their accuracy and request integration, updating or rectification, as well as to have the processing of your personal data restricted and any unlawfully processed data erased, made anonymous or blocked.
