ANNEX 1 - INDIVIDUAL ASSESSMENTS

Candidate: Professor Alberto Di Minin

Prof. Marco Frey

With regard to his **research activity**, the candidate Alberto Di Mini ranks in a very good position in the discipline of management at the national and international levels in terms of quantity and quality of scientific publications.

Currently he has 2,596 citations according to Google Scholars, with an H-Index of 21, and a Scopus H-Index of 14, with a field weighted citation index of 1.08, confirming the results as in line with other Associate Professors active in the field worldwide.

In terms of quality, he presented some very good papers in A Journal that have provided a significant contribution to the development of emerging issues in the fields of innovation management and open innovation, as illustrated in his self-assessment document.

He has also developed innovative, well-received tools and formats for advanced and executive education, he has contributed to science and technology policy and worked with top consultancy firms; moreover, he served as Innovation Advisor to the Minister of Education, University and Research Hon. Maria Chiara Carrozza during the Letta Government during the years 2013-14.

Overall, his work is characterized by a high level of originality and innovation as well as rigor in his research method.

With regard to **teaching activity**, the candidate accumulated significant national and international teaching experience – for instance, together with his teaching activities in important Italian universities, he also taught undergraduate courses in world's top universities such as Berkley and Stanford.

In addition to undergraduate courses, his teaching experience includes post-graduate courses and, in particular, courses in doctoral and PhD programs. In this regard, it can be highlighted his teaching activities of two postgraduate courses of Laurea Magistrale MAIN - Innovation Management and two PhD courses in High Tech Business Venturing and Methodology in Management.

He has been supervisor of several MSc and PhD thesis, as shown in his CV.

With regard to **research projects**, he participated in research projects funded through competitive tenders on European projects, such as two FP7, one Horizon 2020 and one JRC by the European Commission on themes related to management innovation.

The candidate demonstrated a strong ability to attract research funds from public and private entities and to work together with different disciplinary sectors of the School.

With regard to **publishing activities**, the candidate is a member of the editorial committees of prestigious international journals (R&D Management Journal, Creativity and Innovation Management, California Management Review).



Prof. Daniela Baglieri

A) Teaching activities

Dr. Di Minin is currently working with graduate, master and doctoral students at Scuola Superiore S.Anna, University of Pisa, university of Trento and Trieste. In addition, he has been also involved in several international programs and executive education Program . The record indicates that Dr. Di Minin has developed a strong ability to lead and effectively execute several interdisciplinary programs, which aims at crossfertilizing scientific and technological knowledge, open innovation and R&D Strategies and technology policies.

B) Scientific publications

Dr. Di Minin has been an active, and productive scholar who has contributed richly to the field, while working hard to create a positive impact in institutions and community. His work appears in well-known journals attesting to the growing national and international impact of his research. He also has an active and promising research agenda that will further position his as a major contributor to the field.

Given the various projects he is working I believe that Dr. Maine will continue to be an effective and productive researcher over the course of his career.

C) Curriculum

- An high capability in technology transfer both in terms of start up creation (he is founder of a new spin off) and in terms of international scientific and technology networking (very important the networking activity with China)
- Significant cooperation activities and institutional networking with important Italian Public Institutions: in particular he served as Innovation Advisor to the Minister of Education, University and Research Hon. Maria Chiara Carrozza (years 2013-14).
- Excellent ability to disseminate research activities outside the academic circuit (for example through articles in well-known specialized Italian newspapers such as II Sole 24 Ore)

Prof. Gianvito Lanzolla

A) Teaching activities

The submitted documents, including the self-evaluation, show that Dr Di Minin is involved in several teaching and, more broadly, educational activities. His involvement spans degrees, including PhD programs, and geographies. Dr Di Minin has not only delivered successfully several programs, but he has also developed some of them thus showing ability to work at the intersection of disciplines, cultures and audiences. Dr Di Minin's CV shows also a remarkable ability to bring into teaching and education cutting-edge results from his research activity. Overall, I believe that Dr Di Minin's teaching/education output exceeds the criteria set for teaching.



B) Scientific publications

Dr. Di Minin's research areas – i.e., open innovation, R&D strategies, and technology policy - are important and timely. As such, he is an asset for any Department involved in researching topics in innovation management and policy.

On the quantitative side, Dr. Di Minin's bibliometric indexes seem to be higher, or at least on a par, with the set requirements and the benchmarks. His research output has appeared in leading field-specific journals including Research Policy, R&D Management and California Management Review. He has also acted as guest editor / associate editor for some of the leading field-specific journals. His co-authored papers show both the span of his outreach and his ability to work successfully in teams, an increasingly important skill in the contemporary management research field.

Remarkably, Dr. Di Minin show a very strong orientation in disseminating the results of his research for greater impact on enterprises and policy makers and he is a very active and well-known member of the international innovation management / innovation policy community.

Dr. Di Minin is also active in fund raising and he has been the lead investigator of several research projects.

Overall, Dr. Di Minin's CV shows that he is gaining even more research momentum and he is likely to increase even more his research productivity and impact. As such, I believe that Dr Di Minin's research output and research agenda exceeds the criteria set for area "B".

C) Curriculum

Dr. Di Minin's CV show the characteristics, and output, of a strong and generous institution builder and of an academic involved in building bridges between academia and communities. Remarkable in his CV are the achievements in creating bridges between Scuola Superiore Sant' Anna, Italy and China across several dimensions, not only academic. In the same vein, remarkable in his CV are the several activities aimed at increasing the international visibility of Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna and in building

stronger links among practitioners, policy makers and academics. I believe that Dr Di Minin's activities exceeds the criteria set for area "C".

In conclusion, I believe that Dr. Di Minin exceeds the criteria for promotion to Full Professor.

Prof. Frank Piller

I am writing in full support of the appointment for full professorship by Dr. Alberto Di Minin. I had the privilege of following his academic research during the last decade, with a focus on his contributions on open innovation (which also is one of my major fields of research). His publications, have been influential in developing my own research agenda. Overall, I am very much impressed by the accomplishments and contributions to scholarship by Dr. Di Minin and hence strongly support his application.



Research/Scholarship

Starting with his papers on interfirm-partnerships, clusters, and collaborative problem solving by open innovation in SMEs, Dr. Di Minin has been an essential actor in establishing open innovation as one of the leading topics of scientific research in innovation management. Today, all major societies in the field of innovation management (like AOM, IPDMC, PDMA, RAND MGNT, ISPIM) run dedicated conferences or tracks on open innovation, and there are more than 2000 scientific papers on this topic. But Dr. Di Minin was one of the first scholars building a dedicated research agenda in this field, recognizing its importance and impact on modern innovation systems. His focus has been especially on SMEs, complementing the majority of the literature that has focused on open innovation in multinational corporations, but neglecting the true economic power in most economies: innovative small and mid-sized companies. Together with his collaborators, the work by Alberto Di Minin has established thought leadership in this upcoming area of research. At the same time, this also is an area of high relevance in practice and an area that is very attractive to apply for grant and government research, potentially supporting the funding policies of your university.

I was updated about his research endeavor by his publications in journals and conference proceedings, and also his frequent presentations in leading conferences and seminars. I especially like the way how Dr. Di Minin followed a path of true "interdisciplinary scholarship" by becoming part of a large international research group of collaborators.

In all of his fields of expertise, Dr. Di Minin has made great scholarly achievement. he has published more than 20 peer-reviewed papers in respected journals. I see no loss of productivity and output in his research after getting tenure or promotions in his current position – on the

contrary, from our personal interactions and joint research projects I experience a strong drive and dedication for further high-level research.

Concluding, I have no doubt in seeing strong evidence that Dr. Di Minin has achieved international thought leadership in the field of innovation and entrepreneurship in general and open innovation in particular.

Contributions to teaching, learning, and development of a research environment

Despite his focus on scholarly excellence, Dr. Di Minin also managed to work on an impressive rooster of research projects and to acquire a substantial amount of research funding. This engagement allowed Alberto Di Minin to build a very productive and successful international research network that works on current topics in innovation management.



I had the pleasure to listen to several of his presentations on conferences and in research seminars. Based on these experiences, I believe that he is a dedicated academic teacher with very good teaching skills who is able to inspire different audiences, spanning from young students to experienced executives. Personally, I truly enjoyed the opportunities of personal interaction with Dr. Di Minin in the last years. A fact that is differentiating Dr. Di Minin from many peers is his ability to teach to a wide scope of different audiences, from large undergraduate groups to small intensive executive programs. I believe that his strong practice contacts have given his a strong foundation in this regard.

With regard to his services to the academic community, he has been serving or has served as the member of editorial boards, review committees, and program committees of many well established journals and conferences in management research. He also is frequently serving as a member of program committees for international conferences. His advice and skills as an evaluator have been sought by numerous journals, and he has been invited to serve as a guest editor for several highly respected journals.

Comparing Dr. Di Minin's work with other scholars known to me in the field, he is way above the average with regard to his scientific work, his originality, and his skills in developing new research streams.
