DATA CONTROLLER

Under the article 13 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation n. 679/2016, hereinafter GDPR, and the Italian Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 ("Privacy Code regarding the protection of personal data"), Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies, hereinafter the "School", is a registered Data Controller, in the person of the Rector, who is the legal representative of the School (e-mail: protocollo@sssup.legalmail.it, phone: +39 050 883.111).

PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

Your personal data (name, surname, contact information, data about academic or work experience included in your CV) collected during the teaching assignment procedure will be processed by the Institute in order to:

- 1. verify if you satisfy the admission requirements;
- 2. carry out the selection.

The School needs to meet lawful bases in order to process personal data.

The legal basis of the data processing are the following:

- Under sub 1 processing is necessary to fulfil legal obligations of the Controller (article 6, sub c) of GDPR);
- Under sub 2 processing is necessary for the purposes of the School institutional activity (art. 6 sub e) GDPR);

DATA PROCESSING DURATION

Your data will be processed, stored, and communicated in compliance with the European and associated Italian legislation (GDPR and the Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003) as long as it is necessary to carry out the selection and, after that, as long as the School is obliged by legal obligation to store your data, as stated by the law.

For the purposes of archiving and storage, the data necessary for the proper functioning of the public administration will be indefinitely preserved, in compliance with the principle of transparency and the principles of lawfulness, proportionality and minimization, as envisaged in the School's storage regulation.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

As data subject, you shall have the right to obtain at any time confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you exist, to be informed of the content and source of such data, to check their accuracy and request integration, updating or rectification, as well as to have the processing of your personal data restricted and any unlawfully processed data erased, made anonymous or blocked under the conditions stated by articles 17 - 18 of GDPR.

The data subject will also have the right to object on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her, even if the legitimate purposes are coherent with the purposes of the data collection.
