1. THE VENUE

The **Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna** ("the Scuola") is a public, autonomous, special-statute university, which promotes education and research through undergraduate studies, master and PhD programmes in the fields of Social Sciences (Economics and Management, Law, Political Science), and Applied Sciences (Agricultural Research, Engineering, Medical Studies).

The Scuola is located in the heart of Pisa, in the charming Tuscany region.

2. HOW TO REACH PISA



By plane

Pisa International Airport (aka **Galileo Galilei Airport**) (IATA: **PSA**), is the main airport in Tuscany and the 10th in Italy in terms of passengers.

It is a hub for the main European low-cost airway companies (Ryanair and Easyjet), and intercontinental flights to/from Doha and NY are also operated.

Ryanair and Easyjet connect Pisa to most of the main European capitals and to other important destinations at very affordable prices. Before booking with a traditional carrier, it might be worth to have a look at the following websites:

By train

Pisa's Central Train Station is one of the major railway junctions of Tuscany. The lines serving the station include three long-distance lines: the Pisa–Livorno–Rome line, the Pisa–La Spezia–Genoa line and the Pisa–Florence line.

To purchase a train ticket, the quickest and cheapest way is to go through the website of Trenitalia, the main train operator in Italy.

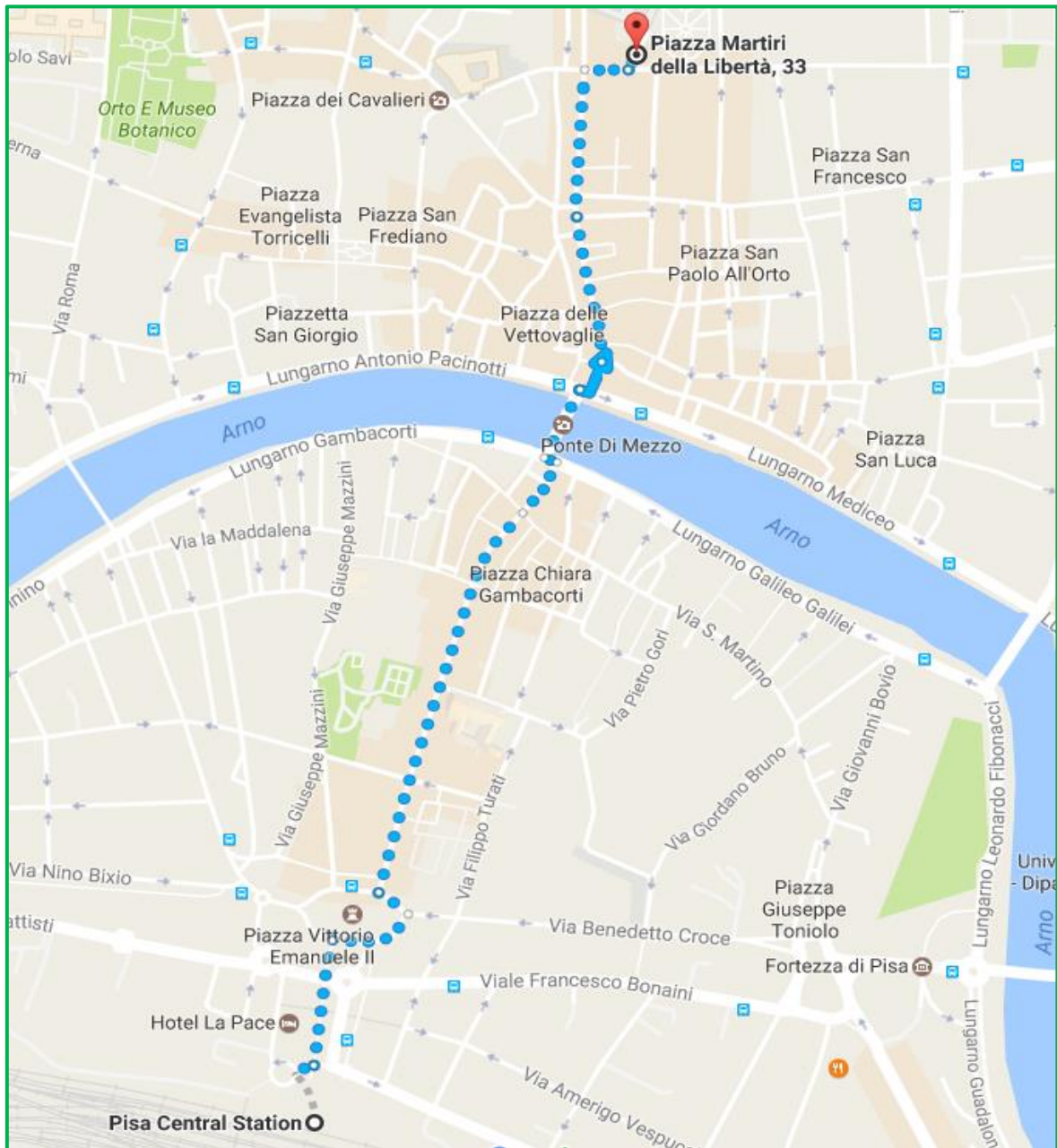
3. HOW TO REACH THE SCUOLA FROM THE RAILWAY STATION AND FROM THE AIRPORT

From the railway station

The Scuola is located in Piazza Martiri della Libertà, 33 and is about 1,4 Km from the Central Train Station.

If you do not have heavy luggage, the best way to reach the Scuola from the railway station is walking (estimated time: 18 minutes).

Here is the quickest route:



In alternative you can take a taxi (it would cost around 13-15 EUR, and it takes about 5 minutes to arrive).

A third option is the local bus service. You can take Bus N.4 (direction "I Passi") and get off at the stop "Santa Caterina". Tickets are sold at newsstands and tobacco shops. A single ticket (valid for 70 minutes) is 1,50 EUR.

From the airport

From the "Galileo Galilei" airport you can reach the Scuola by taxi (the cost is around 15 EUR and it takes 10 minutes to arrive).

Another option is to reach the Railway station and then follow the directions given above.

The quickest way to get to the Railway station is to hop on the *Automated People Mover*, a driverless train that connects the airport to the central train station. You can buy the tickets at automatic vending machines located close to the platform. A single ticket is 2,70 EUR. For further info, visit www.pisa-mover.com/en/ .
