





## **Call for 1 PhD position in Economics**

## Institute of Economics, Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies

A 4-years full scholarship for a Ph.D. position in Economics is available at the <a href="Institute of Economics">Institute of Economics</a> of Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies (Pisa, Italy). The successful candidate will work in close contact with the research groups on climate change economics, innovation, complexity and data science, and macroeconomic analysis. The candidate will also be part of the team working on the ERC project <a href="FIND">FIND</a>, which focuses on the analysis of carbon removals, the development and financing of negative emission technologies and their implications for sustainable development, and of the Complexity Modellers Society (<a href="CoMoS">CoMoS</a>) within the Department of Excellence "<a href="L'EMbeDS"</a>. Additional funding for research stays abroad from 6 to 18 months, travelling to conferences and workshops, and participation to summer and winter schools is available.

The PhD in Economics is a 4-year programme designed for highly qualified and motivated students who wish to acquire the research and analytical skills of the international scientific community in Economics. The Programme is offered in close cooperation with UCA-University of Cote d'Azur (Nice, France). Additional details on the program are available here. After the training period (about 1 year), students will proceed to supervised research work, yielding an original dissertation to be discussed in a final, public examination. The successful candidate is expected to contribute to the ERC project FIND, though her/his research activities may also span beyond the scope of the project. PhD students are exposed to the vivid research environment and participate to various ongoing research activities of the Institute of Economics at Scuola Sant'Anna (seminars, conferences, workshops, research projects). The Programme is also part of a large international network of institutions and scholars, supporting exchanges of research students and faculty. Further, the FIND project also features a partnership with the RFF-CMCC European Institute on the Economics and the Environment, which the candidate can leverage.

Candidates who have completed (or are close to completion) a M.Sc., M.Phil or M.Res in Economics, Finance, Physics, Innovation, Political Science or Data Science are welcomed to apply.

The **deadline** for the application is on **July 11<sup>th</sup>**, **2024** at 11.59am (noon).

The scholarship is expected to start on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
