People who are requested to stay in quarantine are allowed to apply for the Stay Permit at the end of that period therefore they are not anymore obliged to make the application within 8 days after the arrival.

NEW FROM THE 21st of September 2020: IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TRAVELLERS

On 29 July 2020, the Italian Government decided to extend the [nationwide state of emergency](#) until **15 October 2020**, due to the health risks posed by the spread of communicable diseases, especially COVID-19 caused by the new SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus.

Travelling rules vary, depending on the country of origin or destination and the reasons for travelling.
